### AGRICULTURE REPORT 2025/2026 KURDISTAN REGION

The Importance of the Agriculture and Livestock Sector in Kurdistan Agriculture and livestock remain foundational to the economic resilience and food security of the Kurdistan Region. With fertile soils, favorable climate zones, and a long agricultural tradition, the sector can ensure sustainable food production, local employment, and reduced dependency on imports.

### Government Vision and Strategic Goals for 2025

The government aims to enhance food security, modernize agriculture and livestock, encourage private-sector investment, generate employment, and promote sustainable development through modern standards and integrated value chains.

### **Megal Agriculture Project (2025)**

In October 2025, the Kurdistan Regional Government inaugurated the Megal Agriculture Project. The project is a US\$100 million private-sector investment spanning 366 dunams along the Erbil–Gwer road.



### **Project components include:**

- A modern slaughterhouse for livestock.
- A livestock trading and breeding center.
- A wastewater treatment facility.
- A waste incineration unit.
- A trading center for livestock products.
- Green spaces and supporting infrastructure.

The project is expected to create more than 1,000 jobs and significantly boost food safety, modern agricultural standards, and economic diversification.

#### What is Agro Pack & Food Iraq?

<u>Agro Pack & Food Iraq</u> is the leading trade fair in Iraq for the agro-food, food-processing, packaging, and related industries. The trade fair is organized by fairtrade Messe GmbH & Co. KG (Germany) and So Fuar Ltd. (Turkey).

The 2025 edition of Agro Pack & Food Iraq, held from 24 to 27 November at the Erbil International Fairground, covers the full value chain: from agriculture and livestock, to food processing, packaging, plastics, and equipment supply.

In 2025, the exhibition space spans 17,000 m<sup>2</sup>, hosting 400+ exhibitors from many countries, and attracting 15,000+ professional visitors (agropackiraq.com)

The fair brings together global suppliers of modern agricultural and food-industry technologies, from livestock breeding and dairy equipment to feeding systems, processing machinery, packaging, and supply chain solutions, organized by a German Company under the name fairtrade Messe.

This makes Agro Pack & Food Iraq a strategic hub for investors, producers, policymakers, and international partners targeting Iraq's agricultural and food sectors. The fair not only showcases technology, but also enables knowledge transfer, networking, investment matching, and the strengthening of the national food supply chain.

Iraq's growing dependence on imports of food, packaging, and food-processing technologies underscores the importance of such a platform. Between 2015 and 2023, imports of food and packaging-processing technology increased from roughly €76 million to €239 million (making Iraq one of the largest importers in the Arab Middle East).

Given this context, Agro Pack & Food Iraq plays a key role in promoting "Made-in-Iraq" production, supporting food security, and attracting investment into local agriculture and agro-industry.

**Presenting a comprehensive package**: from livestock genetics (via Zuchtvieh-Export & GGI-SPERMEX), to feeding systems and farm machinery (via Himel), offering integrated solutions for Kurdistan's livestock & dairy ambitions.
