The 2026 INTF edition highlights Iraq's journey toward economic diversification, sustainable growth, and deeper integration into global trade and investment networks. It underscores the importance of leveraging trade and investment to create jobs, modernize key sectors like agri-food, digital and net-zero economy while strengthening partnerships with key international actors, notably the European Union and development finance institutions, in support of Iraq's long-term economic transformation.

INTF 2026 follows a clear progression: from high-level political vision and reform commitments in the morning, to practical discussions on financing, de-risking and value chains in the afternoon, and to partnerships and implementation in Day 2.
